DEFINITIONS.

- **TRYSQUAAD:** Refers to the digital platform operated and managed by BRINNEX LLC, which facilitates the management and organization of sports services and other events.

1. INTRODUCTION.

At TRYSSQUAAD, we value the privacy and security of our users' data. This guide explains the rights users have concerning their personal data and how they can exercise these rights.

2. SCOPE.

This guide applies to all personal data collected by TRYSSQUAAD, regardless of the means by which it is obtained or processed.

3. USER RIGHTS.

- **Right of Access:** Users have the right to request and obtain a copy of the personal data that TRYSSQUAAD holds about them.
- **Right to Rectification:** Users can request the correction of inaccurate or incomplete personal data.
- **Right to Erasure (Right to be Forgotten):** Users can request the deletion of their personal data when it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.
- **Right to Restriction of Processing:** Users can request the restriction of processing of their personal data under certain circumstances.

- **Data Portability Right:** Users have the right to receive the personal data they have provided to TRYSQUAAD in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, and they have the right to transmit that data to another controller.
- **Right to Object:** Users can object to the processing of their personal data for reasons related to their situation.

4. HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS.

Users can exercise their rights by contacting TRYSQUAAD's Data Protection Officer (DPO) through the contact form provided on our website. A direct link will be provided to facilitate access.

5. RESPONSE TIMES.

TRYSQUAAD is committed to responding to all legitimate requests as promptly as possible. The time required to address a request may vary based on the complexity and nature of the request.

6. COMPLAINTS.

If users are dissatisfied with how their data is handled or how their request has been managed, they have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority.

7. CHANGES TO THE GUIDE.

This guide may be updated periodically to reflect changes in our data processing practices or relevant legislation. Users will be informed of any significant changes.
